Biblical Languages

When the Scriptures first came to us they were in the ancient languages of Hebrew, Aramaic, and Koine Greek. This module focuses particularly on Koine and its translation into English, equipping students with a basic understanding as well as some tools to use in their Christian life and ministry.

Missional Vocation of the Church

Because God's plan was for His people to come together to join Him on a cosmic mission, this module covers one important aspect of that mission: evangelism. Students will explore ways that God's mission connects with that of His church, and they will also be involved in evangelistic events.

New Testament Discipleship

This module explores the first century meaning of 'discipleship' and examines the heart of Jesus along with his core teachings, as a means to discover its essence. Attention is also given to other New Testament Biblical teachings which outline the dynamics involved in the application of discipleship concepts and principles in the life of a Christian.

Exodus-Exile

The key to understanding the Old Testament and the intense anticipation for a Messiah lies between the Exodus and the Exile. As students come to understand and empathise with Israel's experience through its highs under David and lows in captivity, they will follow the transition from the Israelite Exodus to the Jewish Exile.

Art of Preaching

Even for those who do not intend to become a fulltime minister or preacher, communication skills are essential in today's relational world. Learning under a gifted preacher and church leader, students will learn to prepare and deliver their own Bible studies.

Synoptic Gospels: Matthew and Mark

Knowing how the Synoptic Gospels work is a gateway to understanding Jesus' goal and ministry in a deeper way than ever before. Students will experience the different emphases of Matthew and Mark's accounts of the greatest story ever told.
